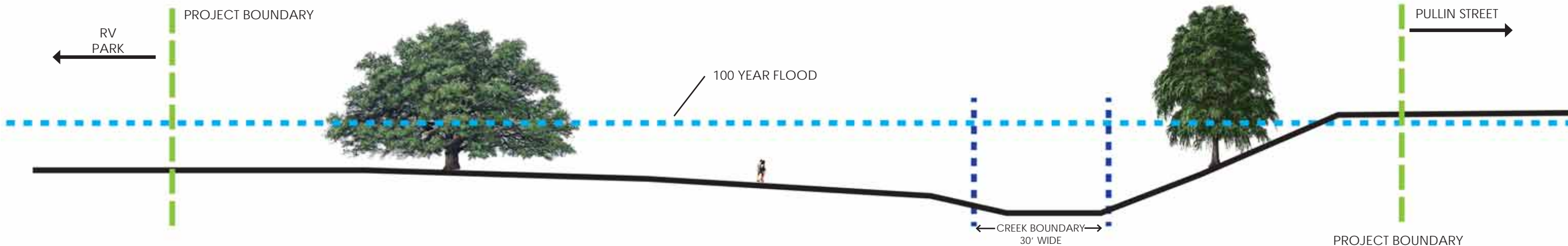

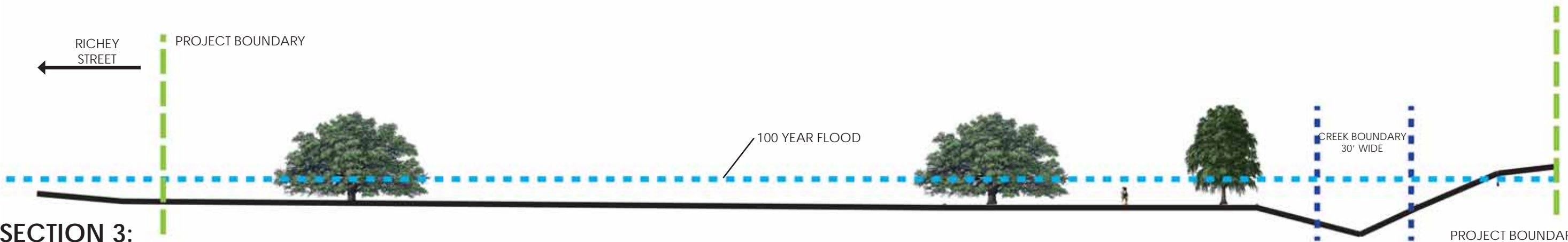

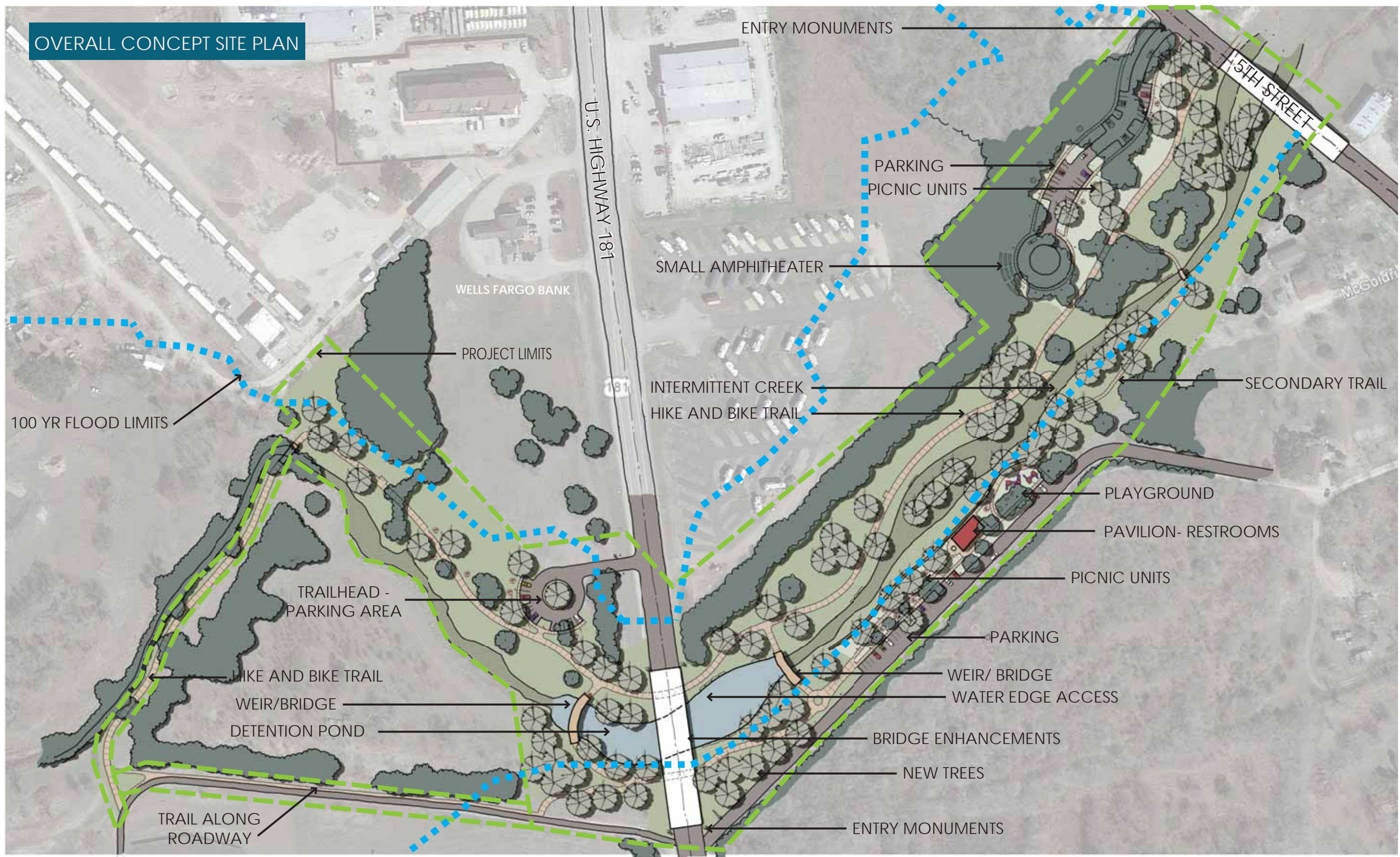

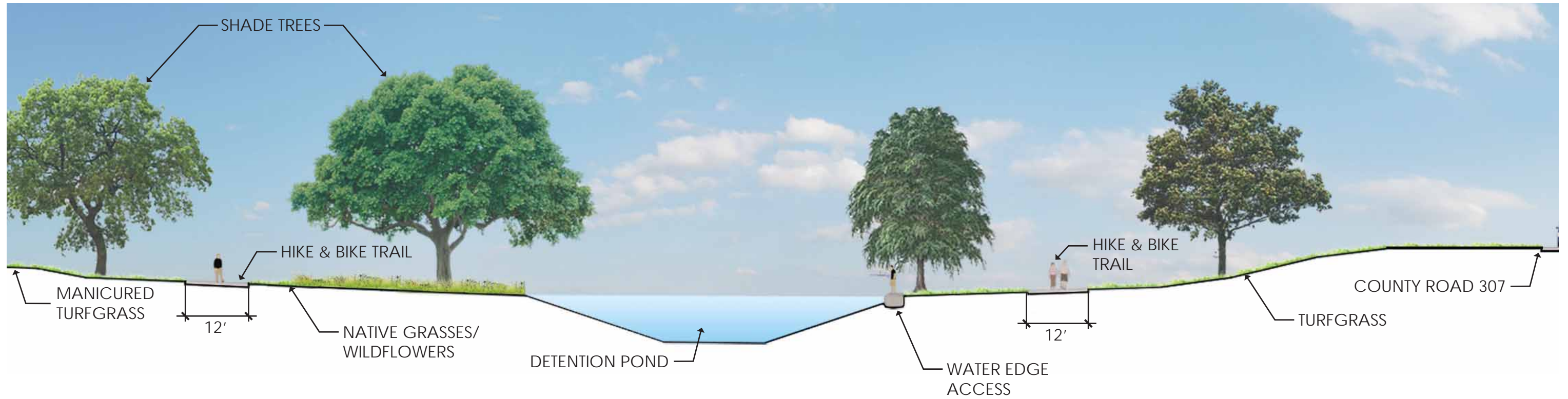

non-manicured/native grass areas:

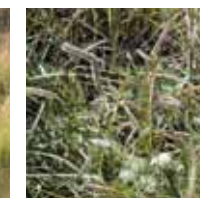
- temporary irrigation during establishment

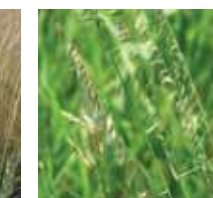
